DoDAF V2.0 – Contrast and Transition from V1.5

Kendall Young is a 26 year aerospace & defense professional with experience in structural / mechanic design and enterprise architecture. Ken has practiced Enterprise Architecture for 10 years and was DoDAF certified by FEAC Institute in 2004. Mr. Young has utilized IBM System Architect on numerous domain, technology, proposal, and program DoDAF implementations. Ken's current assignment is with Northrop Grumman Aerospace Sector, Advanced Programs & Technologies as Program Manager, Chief Architect, Enterprise Architectures.

Mr. Young's technical interests include: Enterprise Architecture, distributed architecture teaming and development, architecture development and deployment tooling, and lean, rapid EA development techniques.

Ken will utilize materials from the recent DoD CIO EA Conference in San Antonio to highlight the key facets of DoDAF V2.0. Directions to INCOSE-SCC Meeting Location: The meeting will be at the First United Methodist Church in Melbourne. The Church is located at 110 E New Haven Ave (aka SR 192). This is three blocks east of intersection of 192 and Babcock, on the north side of New Haven Ave. From New Haven turn north onto Platt Street. The church parking lot immediately on your left. There is also parking next to the church on your right. At the Northern-most section of the facility is a two story building with a set of double glass doors. Above the doors it says "Life Enrichment Center". Enter these doors and straight ahead will be a counter with a receptionist.
